CONDITIONS

- 1. 10 teams have entered The Prince of Wales Trophy. Teams have been placed into two leagues of five playing two league matches.
- 2. Order of Merit will be decided using the HPA Year Book 2024. If necessary, a Penalty Shoot Out will be held, after the league phase to decide the order of merit between teams tied on points. Two team players are required. Rules to follow.
- 3. Matches will be scheduled on grounds, other than at RCBPC, which have been approved by the HPA for high goal tournaments or the two involved teams agree. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to provide a suitable venue for every match and it is a condition of entry that teams agree to play on any ground approved by the HPA for high goal tournaments whether private or club.
- 4. A free change will be offered by the Umpires to both teams at the halfway point in each chukka in the league phase, this does not apply for the Final.
- 5. Umpires and referees will be selected from the HPA Professional Umpire Group and invoiced by the HPA.
- 6. Each team is to provide two suitable umpire ponies for each of their matches, tacked and bandaged as for polo and if required must have been warmed up before it is handed over to the umpires.
- 7. Goals will be widened in accordance with HPA Rules. They will not be widened for the seventh chukka should teams be tied at the end of the sixth.
- 8. For the purposes of substitution, The HPA Year Book 2024, Substitution Rules for 22 Goal will apply. Teams are reminded to inform the Polo Office by mid-day the day prior with a list of their substitutes.
- 9. All players must wear a HPA compliant helmet whilst playing polo and grooms must wear a hard hat with the chin strap correctly in place whenever on horseback. No ponies are allowed to be warmed up or held in the safety zones during play.
- 10. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final in any dispute.
- 11. Whenever there is a prize presentation in the tournament, each and every member of the team will be ready and present no later than 10 minutes after the end of the match. Please note that only players and officials are permitted in the presentation area for the prize giving and that players are to be dressed in team colours, whites and boots.
- 12. The Trophy is to be insured by the winning team from the day it is presented until the finals of the next season's tournament. Please contact the office regarding the valuation for insurance purposes.
- 13. Photography/Recordings: It is a condition of entry to the Royal County of Berkshire Polo Club tournaments that each and every team member agrees without formal formality:
 - to being photographed and/or recorded by film, video, television cameras and sound equipment at all times when they are present at any event relating to a tournament, whether or not such event takes place at the grounds of RCBPC;
 - ii. to surrender all rights in respect of such photographs and recordings.

It is the responsibility of either the Patron, Manager or Captain to ensure that all players and grooms in a team are made aware of the above rules and conditions and have agreed to be bound by them.
